ShotSpotter raises \$12M in 3rd round

ShotSpotter Inc., which focuses on gunshot location systems and technology for public safety and the military, said Tuesday it raised \$12 million in a third round of funding.

Santa Clara-based ShotSpotter said the round was led by San Francisco-based Levensohn Venture Partners.

Other participants in the funding included Oakland-based Claremont Creek Ventures, Greenwich, Conn.-based City Light Capital, and Palo Alto-based Labrador Ventures.

Pascal Levensohn of Levensohn Partners and Stuart Davidson of Labrador Ventures join the seven-member ShotSpotter board of directors.

The company said it has signed recent contracts with the US Department of Defense.
