## Boston police choose ShotSpotter technology

The city of Boston has chosen ShotSpotter Inc. technology as a new crime-fighting tool, the company said Tuesday.

Santa Clara-based ShotSpotter, which provides gunshot location systems and technology for public safety and the military, did not disclose financial terms of the deal.

The company said its technology will give Boston police the ability to arrive on the scene of a gunshot faster, and the system will be launched in areas with high firearm violence.

ShotSpotter is venture funded.
