PUBLIC SAFETY SUCCESS STORY

Perris Police Department Recovers Stolen Firearms and Ghost Guns with the Help of ShotSpotter

SITUATION

The city of Perris has historically struggled with a high rate of unreported gunfire incidents, but in 2020, the situation grew more dire. A surge in unreported homicides that year ultimately led the police department to seek out ShotSpotter as an effective means of reporting on and responding to the increasingly prevalent threat of gunfire.

RESULTS

Following the implementation of ShotSpotter, the Perris PD is now consistently dispatched to the precise location of gunfire incidents, enabling officers to collect more evidence, solve more cases, and reliably uphold community safety.

One notable incident occurred on Christmas Eve 2022, when a call came in reporting a homicide in front of a house. By leveraging ShotSpotter, the Perris PD was able to identify other shootings that night in the vicinity that led up to the homicide, and through corroborating witness statements, was ultimately able to connect the perpetrators.

In another incident, deputies responded to a ShotSpotter detection and discovered shell casings at the scene as well as six firearms, including two rifles and three ghost guns. The suspect was then arrested, reassuring the community.

HOW SHOTSPOTTER BENEFITS THE PERRIS POLICE DEPARTMENT

AUGMENTS PATROL

ShotSpotter puts the Perris PD in the precise location of gunfire, which ensures that officers' time is better spent collecting evidence, speaking to witnesses, and rendering aid if needed.

FAST RESPONSE

Timely tactical information about gunshot incidents helps improve the Perris PD's effectiveness at the scene, during evidence collection, and during subsequent investigations.

STRONGER COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Faster response times help deter gun violence, ultimately building trust and improving the relationship between the Perris PD and the community.
